PSAT 8/9 at a Glance

The PSAT" 8/9 is the first test in the SAT[®] Suite of Assessments and is designed for 8th or 9th graders to take as they start their high school journey.

Structured similarly to the SAT, the PSAT 8/9 focuses on the reading, writing, and math skills your teen is learning in school and that matter most for college and career readiness.

Guide Your Teen to Set and Achieve Their Goals

There's no need to stress about the PSAT 8/9. The best way students can prepare is by focusing on the skills they're learning in class and becoming familiar with the test and it's format. Your teen will:



Know Where They Are—and Where They Can Go. As your teen begins their high school journey, results from the PSAT 8/9 help set a baseline so they'll know what skills they can improve.



Explore Career Options. Your teen's score report includes Career Insights Snapshot, a list of growing careers in their state that connect to their skills measured by the SAT Suite. The list has examples, not recommendations, that can broaden their awareness of career options. For careers that reflect their interest, they can discover almost 1,000 options on **BigFuture.org**.



Find Out About Their Likelihood to Succeed in AP. Based on their scores, students will get personalized recommendations about what **AP**^{*} courses might be a good fit for them.



DIGITAL FORMAT

Every test in the SAT Suite of Assessments is now administered in a digital format. Students have more time per question, shorter reading passages, and access to a built-in Desmos graphing calculator that can be used on the entire math section.
